Measures for the 1st Semester and 2nd Quarter Final Examinations at Rokkodai First Campus (AY2026)

Due to ongoing safety improvement work at the Student Hall, the area surrounding the building is currently closed to pedestrian traffic. As a result, travel between Tsurukabuto 1st Campus and Rokkodai 1st Campus is taking longer than usual.

In light of these circumstances, to ensure sufficient travel time between the two campuses, the following measures will apply to all Spring Semester and Second Quarter final examinations (excluding regular class sessions) administered by the Faculties of Law, Economics, and Business Administration at Rokkodai First Campus during the examination period.

- **90-minute examinations:** The start time will be delayed by 5 minutes, the end time will be moved forward by 5 minutes, and the examination duration will be reduced to **80 minutes**.
- **80-minute examinations:** The start time will be delayed by 5 minutes.
- **60-minute examinations:** The start time will be delayed by 5 minutes.

Accordingly, the examination start times for each period are as follows:

Period 1	8 : 55 a.m.
Period 2	10 : 45 a.m.
Period 3	1 : 25 p.m.
Period 4	3 : 15 p.m.
Period 5	5 : 05 p.m.

As examination end times vary depending on the duration of each examination, please be sure to check the examination timetable on the website of the faculty offering your course.
