

## Designated Courses for Doctoral Qualifying Examinations

- ✓ For a Designated Course for which you have **not yet** earned credits, **register for the course**, as usual, via URIBO-net during the course registration period. Application for the qualifying examination is not necessary.<sup>1)</sup>
- ✓ For a Designated Course for which you have **already** earned credits (with a grade of B or C), please submit the **application form** to the Student Affairs Office.<sup>2)</sup>
- ✓ If you are a doctoral student and earned credits in a Designated Course when you were a master's student here, you can **register for the same course** again with the title of "Special Lecture."<sup>1)</sup>
  - If you register for the course, application is not necessary.
  - If you do not register for the course, please submit the **application form**.
- ✓ If you have completed the doctoral coursework without doctoral degree and earned credits in Designated Courses before withdrawing from the university, you may take the examination for those courses if you submit the **application form**.<sup>2)</sup>
  - This rule does not apply if your Student Rule Book (学生便覧) is 2013 or older.
- ✓ Examination results are posted on the website in
  - Late October for Spring semester (Q1~2)
  - Late March for Fall semester (Q3~4)

<sup>1)</sup> If you register for a Designated Course, you pass the Designated Course if you receive a grade of "S" or "A" in the course.
